| The outline proposal presented to Lloyd's in June 1979 showed a building with all the essential elements that were eventually constructed. It was to total around 48,000 square metres (522,000 square feet), a 66 per cent increase on the existing accommodation and required the demolition of the 1928 building, restricting Lloyd's of London's operations to the 1958 Lime Street site during construction. |
